

Matisse and Illustrated Books Matisse, Fauvism, and Modern Chinese Painting



作为二十世纪最伟大的艺术家之一、艺术史上数次重大变革的推动 者, 亨利·马蒂斯 1869 年 12 月 31 出生于法国的勒卡托 - 康布雷齐, 他的家族在该地区经营纺织业已经300余年。1952年,年事已高 的马蒂斯决定在家乡建立一座美术馆,并捐赠了自己始终珍藏的89 件作品,构成其独一无二的艺术遗产。马蒂斯的创作风格独树一帜, 而且是一位拥有普世精神的艺术家,对不同国家与地区的文化充满 兴趣,尤其是中国的艺术与思想。"马蒂斯的马蒂斯"汇集来自法国 北方省省立马蒂斯美术馆的近300件珍贵作品与藏品,遵循艺术 家的人生与创作发展顺序讲述马蒂斯的艺术生涯, 以期向观众全面 呈现这位艺术巨匠的艺术探索与成果, 及其经久不衰的影响力。

展览分为11个部分,以马蒂斯在学院时期的首批习作、临摹古典 大师的作品和风格探索开篇。随后通过马蒂斯开创的"野兽派"的 代表作,以及雕塑、素描、版画等不同媒介的作品,全方位再现了 自 1920 年代至 1930 年代, 马蒂斯对于人像的探索。接下来的章节 分别呈现了1930年的塔希提之旅给予马蒂斯的持续创作灵感,以 及1940年代其事业巅峰时期的标志性油画与墨水线条画,并集中 展现了马蒂斯投身剪纸创作的革命性转变,包括剪纸技法集大成之 作的艺术书《爵士》,以及剪纸创作对插画和书籍设计的影响。另 外,展览还介绍了织物和服饰对于理解马蒂斯作品的重要性,以及 马蒂斯晚年设计的旺斯礼拜堂——作为其创作生涯的完美总结。展 览最后还设立了一个特别展区,对马蒂斯及野兽派对 1920 年代至 1940 年代中国现代绘画运动的影响展开探讨。

此次展览的展陈和空间设计参考了马蒂斯亲自为以自己命名的美术 馆设计的展览空间和陈列方式,在向这位艺术大师丰富的灵感与旺 盛的创作生命力致敬的同时,也邀请观众开启此次独一无二的艺术 探索之旅——而为我们担任导览的,正是艺术家马蒂斯本人。

Today considered one of the greatest artists of the twentieth century and the impetus behind several major developments in the history of art, Henri Matisse was born in Le Cateau-Cambrésis in the north of France on December 31, 1869. He came from a family of weavers who had lived in the area for more than 300 years. In 1952, nearing the end of his life, he decided to create a museum there by donating 89 works, his favorites that he had never wanted to sell, which would represent his unique artistic legacy. Unique among his peers, Matisse was a universal artist: transcending borders, curious about all civilizations, and particularly admiring of Chinese art and thought, "Matisse by Matisse" attempts to tell the story of his life both chronologically and thematically. It traces his research, discoveries, achievements, and influence through almost 300 works of art, drawn from the collection of the Musée

départemental Matisse, Le Cateau-Cambrésis.

The exhibition includes eleven sections, beginning with his stylistic explorations as a student, early studies and copies of Old Masters: works that show his progression towards Fauvism, which he invented; and his portrait studies from the 1920s and 1930s, in media such as sculptures, drawings, and prints. Other sections explore the inspiration and influence of his 1930 trip to Tahiti; an iconic suite of oil paintings and ink drawings from the 1940s, one of the artist's most prolific periods; and his revolutionary shift to paper cut-outs, including Jazz and its impact on illustration and book design. The exhibition continues to examine the significance of textiles in his work and the culmination of his oeuvre, the creation of the Vence Chapel at the end of his life. It concludes with a section that explores the influence of Matisse and Fauvism on modern painting in China from the 1920s to 1940s.

The show's design and architecture are inspired by Matisse's universe of forms. Paying tribute to the artist's energy and creative longevity, it offers a unique and privileged way to discover Matissewith the artist himself as our esteemed guide.

"Matisse by Matisse" is curated by Patrice Deparpe, Director and Chief Curator, Musée départemental Matisse, Le Cateau-Cambrésis. The exhibition is designed by Pascal Rodriguez and coordinated by the art and culture agency Doors 门艺. "Matisse by Matisse" is presented with special support from the French Embassy in China as part of the 17th edition of the Croisements Festival.

在展览举办期间,北京 UCCA 尤伦斯当代艺术中心将围绕展览所 涉及的马蒂斯的生平创作、世纪交际时期的艺术史与历史线索、 结合马蒂斯及现代艺术对中国近代美术运动的影响与思潮,策划6 个主题周末集中呈现,包括对话6场、工作坊6场、影像艺术交 流 5 场、表演 1 场。其中,表演艺术交流"尚未终结的'二徐之争' 将关注西方艺术最初进入国人视野时所引发的争议,结合当代艺术 教育专业化与文化现代性的主体问题,以历史文本为素材,重写文 献,排演历史。系列对话"现代性的前夜"将以城市化运动、流行 商品文化与艺术史三个角度,探寻二十世纪上半叶中国现代美术运 动发生的社会背景与"东中有西"的文化发展脉络。

During the exhibition period, UCCA Beijing will present six weekends of public programs exploring Matisse's artistic career, art and history at the turn of the twentieth century, and the artist's influence on the Chinese modern art movement. Programs include conversations, workshops, film screenings, and a performance. The performance "The Unfinished Battle of the Two Xus." will explore how modern Western art sparked debate when it was first introduced to China The presentation also touches upon questions of professionalization and cultural modernity in contemporary art education, drawing from historical texts to rewrite and reenact history. In addition, the theme "The Eve of Modernity" will explore the social background and development of modern art in China in the first half of the twentieth century from the three perspectives of urbanization, popular and consumer culture, and art history.

关于法国北方省省立马蒂斯美术馆, 勒卡托 - 康布雷齐 About Musée départemental Matisse, Le Cateau-Cambrésis

法国北方省省立马蒂斯美术馆,勒卡托-康布雷齐位于法国勒卡托-康布雷齐的法国北方省省立马蒂斯美术馆由马蒂斯本人在其家乡建 立,是拥有世界上最重要的马蒂斯藏品的美术馆之一。1952年, 马蒂斯向勒卡托 - 康布雷齐捐赠了 89 幅作品,并且亲自参与展厅 布置。马蒂斯去世之后,美术馆的馆藏不断扩大,分别于 1956 年 得到法国抽象画家奥古斯特 · 赫尔宾(Auguste Herbin)的捐赠, 以及 2000 年得到来自艺术书籍出版人爱丽斯·特利亚德(Alice Tériade) 的一批珍贵艺术书籍以及现代派大师作品的捐赠。美术 馆最开始位于勒卡托 - 康布雷齐的市政厅内,1982 年搬迁至始建 于18世纪的费奈隆宫内,目前美术馆正在筹备全新的扩建整修计划。

Located in Henri Matisse's hometown of Le Cateau-Cambrésis in northern France, Musée départemental Matisse was founded by the artist and houses one of the most important collections of his works in the world. In 1952, Matisse bequeathed 82 of his works to the city of Le Cateau-Cambrésis and personally participated in the design of the exhibition galleries. The museum's collection continued to enlarge after Matisse's death, with a gift from French abstract painter Auguste Herbin in 1956, and another, of books and works by Modernist masters, from art publisher Alice Tériade in 2000. Musée départemental Matisse originally opened in the Town Hall of Le Cateau-Cambrésis, moving in 1982 to the Fénelon Palace, built during the eighteenth century. In 1992, it became the property of the Département du Nord and ten years later, it was significantly enlarged. The museum is currently undergoing renovation in preparation for a new expansion, and will open in
